While many issues are vying for your attention at this point, on behalf of your home club, I'd like to ask you to give special consideration to one in particular. There is an effort to declare New York City a Peace Zone on April 26, 2006 in order to draw attention to the apparently reckless militarism of the Bush Administration. CRDC's Executive Committee voted unanimously to ask me to write and request your support for this initiative. In addition, the groups sponsoring this event have recommended that the City Council pass the resolution; we are in concurrence with this recommendation.

Please give this matter your careful - and timely - consideration. What happened in our City is nearly always used by the administration as cover for its action. It is critical that we stand hard and fast for a better approach and a brighter possibility.
